## **SEPTEMBER 16, 2024**

Today, September 16, 2024, President Joseph R. Biden Jr., granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Louisiana triggering the release of Federal funds to help people and communities recover from Hurricane Francine that occurred September 9-12, 2024.
